



## Pedestrian & Youth Sector Guidelines Supported by National Youth Agency

The health and safety of our young people and our staff/ tutors is of the upmost importance to us at Pedestrian. We will always follow Government guidelines to ensure everyone is kept safe.

We continue following the guidance set out by the National Youth Agency, who are continually working closely with the Department of Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS). As restrictions have now eased, the readiness level is Green.

Our Alternative Education Provision continues to follow education guidance however our projects will run following the below guidance:

### GREEN LEVEL

For all ages, under 18 and over 18's (as of 27<sup>th</sup> January 2022)

- All young people will be able to attend indoor or outdoor activities.
- Youth provision for young people of all ages, both under and over 18 years of age, have the same requirements.
- All youth provision may meet indoors or outdoors without limitations on group size. The regulations no longer require youth sector providers to operate bubble sizes or limit group sizes to a maximum number of attendees outside of measures usually in place for safe working practices
- Online/digital, detached/outdoor and 1-2-1 youth sector provision will remain available to all young people.
- Trips and visits are permitted.
- Travel by minibus, taxi, public transport, or private car (subject to safeguarding) are permitted. The youth sector's goal at all times should be to minimise the risk of COVID transmission.
